Qualifications:

Current CDL Class A Minnesota Drivers License (or ability to obtain); squeaky clean driving record; 21 years of age or older; Drug Screen and DOT Physical required; ISA certified arborist preferred with previous green industry experience; the ability to properly identify tree and shrubbery plant material; prune shrubbery, hedges and small trees; remove small and large trees with either a crane or conventional roping and rigging; ability to communicate (both in verbal and written form) with customers and co-workers; able and willing to work outside in both hot and cold weather, with occasional long days and/or weeks; MINIMUM 2 YEARS EXPERIENCE IN TREE CARE FIELD.

Under the direction and supervision of the Tree Crew Manager, this person will supervise a tree crew; perform procedures at job sites as per work orders; able to properly climb trees with rope and saddle and operate a bucket truck; properly prune trees according to ANSI standards and company standards; attend conferences and seminars as needed and required; must become a Minnesota State Tree Inspector; able to drive safely with all of our trucks and equipment and take proper care of them; help with all aspects of tree work on job site such as pruning, removals, stump grinding and clean up of site; work with fellow employees with respect, safety and customer care; perform daily light duty maintenance on trucks and equipment that you are responsible for.
